Uniform and Personal Presentation Policy

At St. Peter's Cross Keys Academy pupils wear their uniform with pride, with school uniform showing that each child is part of the Academy community. We have the highest expectations for our pupils with regards to school uniform and appearance. Through these high expectations we aim to create a strong community where all children know they belong and can flourish.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

We encourage all our children to wear their uniform smartly.

All items of uniform **must** be labelled with your child's name and class.

Uniform with the school logo is available for purchase from the school office (prices of this are on our school website).

Uniform consists of the following:

- ☒ white/red polo shirt or white shirt
- ☒ red jumper/cardigan (these do not have to have the school logo on them)
- ☒ charcoal/grey/black trousers (shorts may be worn in all year round if your child wishes)
- ☒ charcoal/grey/black skirt or pinafore (red & white checked dress for warmer weather)
- ☒ Socks or tights should always be worn with shoes – no bare feet.
- ☒ black flat school shoes.
- ☒ Only Year 6 – White shirt and a school tie, to be worn during lessons at all times. Children may remove their tie at playtimes. The tie is provided by the school but if lost, a replacement must be purchased from the school office.

PE KIT – indoor and outdoor

Pupils will wear PE kit **for the whole day** on those days their class has a PE lesson. They need a **labelled** PE kit consisting of the following:

- ☒ navy T-shirt (logo version available from school)
- ☒ black shorts
- ☒ plain black tracksuit top and bottoms for outdoor games in cold weather – (**logos are not permitted – we have a stock of clean plain black tops and bottoms in school which can be borrowed temporarily until parents provide the correct P.E kit**)
- ☒ Black, white or navy trainers

Jewellery

- Jewellery should not be worn or brought into school.
- If your child has pierced ears, ONE pair of small studs may be worn. These **earrings must be removed for PE lessons and swimming** for health and safety reasons. If your child is unable to remove the earrings themselves they should not come to school with them in on PE days. If your child has recently had their ears pierced, you will need to send them to school with tape to cover their earrings until they are able to remove them.
- Pupils may wear a watch. Please do not wear smart watches to school.

Hairstyles:

- Long hair must be tied back. This helps prevent the spread of head lice as well as for safety in school.

- Hair accessories e.g. hairbands or bows must not cause a distraction to learning.

Forest School

- On forest school days children must come to school in their school uniform and then get changed into their forest school clothes.
- Long sleeve top and trousers must be worn. (In adverse weather conditions messages will be sent out if there is changes to this).
- Outdoor shoes (wellingtons/boots)
- There are also additional clothes that can be worn according to the season and weather:
 - Raincoat
 - Jumper
 - Hat, gloves, scarf


Other:

- Boots (wellingtons or snow boots) are allowed in wet weather/snow, but must be changed when inside the school buildings.
- Black trainers are allowed to be worn during the school day as well as for PE lessons and clubs.
- Make up and nail varnish should not be worn to school. If children do come to school with nail varnish a reminder will be given to remove it that evening when they get home.
