

**Year 6**

Know how to identify the type of text that Psalm 8 is, and its purpose to Christians.

Know how to explain what Psalm 8 has to say about the idea of God as Creator and the place of humans in Creation.

Know how spirituality is a key aspect of three religious creation stories and give examples of how this spirituality is embedded in the practice of these religions.

Know how to show understanding of why Christians and Humanists have opposing views on creation.

**Year 5**

Know how to show understanding of why many Christians find science and faith go together.

Know how to identify key ideas arising from their study of Genesis 1 and comment on how the Genesis 1 creation narrative is in conflict, or is complementary, with a scientific account.

Know how to make connections between 3 different religious creation stories and why these are often the first story in holy text.

**Year 4**

Know the importance of Creation on the timeline of the 'big story' of the Bible.

Know that the Bible tells a story (in Genesis 3) about how humans spoiled their friendship with God (sometimes called 'the Fall').

Know and explain which Hindu gods are responsible for creation.

**Year 3**

Know how to place the concepts of God and Creation on a timeline of the Bible's 'Big Story'.

Know how to make links between Genesis 1 and what Christians believe about God and Creation.

Know how to explain the Islamic creation story.

Know that there are similarities and differences between the Islamic and Christian creation story.

**Year 2**

Know that the story of creation comes at the beginning of the Bible and why.

Know what the message of the creation story means to Christians.

Know at least two examples of what Christians do to look after the world for God.

Know why the seventh day of the creation story is important for both Christians and Jews.

Know how Jewish people give thanks to God for creation.

**Year 1**

Know that Christians believe God created the universe.

Know that Christians believe that the Earth and everything in it are important to God.

Know that Christians believe that God has a unique relationship with human beings as their Creator and Sustainer.

Know that humans should care for the world because it belongs to God.

**F2**

Know that God is important to Christians.

Know that Christians believe that God created the world.

Know that Christians believe God created all life.

Know how to retell the creation story using simple props.
