Maths

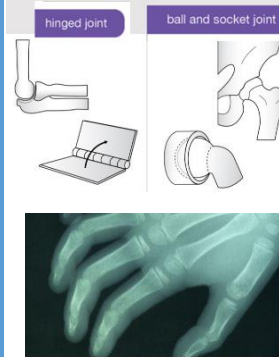
- Recall & use multiplication & division facts for 3, 4, 8 tables.

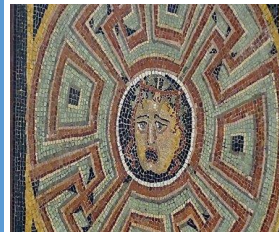
Humanities Essential Knowledge
