

Year 6

Know how to explore vocabulary using different techniques
Know how to respond to questions, to express and justify an opinion on a range of themes, including sport
Know how to agree/disagree with another opinion
Know the French vocabulary for the names of countries around the world and say where I or someone else comes from
Know how to conjugate the verb 'to go' (aller) and say I or someone else is going to a country
Know how to use prepositions to indicate the position of objects, including: the bedroom
Know a wide range of descriptive phrases, e.g. houses, route to school
Know how to recognise present and future tense sentences using aller- to go
Know how to ask extended questions e.g. rooms in the house e.g. town, sightseeing
Know how to describe what you would pack in a suitcase for a holiday

Year 5

Know some regular verbs in the present tense
Know how to pick out key ideas and phrases in a longer piece of spoken French
Know how to form a question in order to ask for information e.g. family and how to use intonation and gesture to differentiate between statements and question
Know how to present factual information in extended sentences including justification e.g. planets
Know how to say if I have a brother or sister and name different family members on a family tree
Know how to join in with and perform a story, and adapt a story and retell it to the class e.g. A week in the life
Know how to use different adjectives, correctly positioned and agreed, to describe e.g. animal, family
Know how to use the language of opinions and comparison e.g. planets
Know vocabulary for numbers, prices and foods and how to describe a quantity of different food nouns
Know how build and deliver a short presentation, choosing and using a range of action verbs, including about my family

Year 4

Know and understand some conversational phrases e.g. ordering food
Know how to speak in full sentences using known vocabulary and to plan and perform a short presentation e.g. weather, temperature
Know how to recognise and use vocabulary and adjectives relating to: clothing, shops and to describe someone's appearance or character
Know how to ask and give personal information and opinions e.g. birthdays and music
Know numbers to 31 and use these to solve maths calculations
Know the days of the week, months of the year
Know weather phrases, and make statements about the weather, points of the compass and the weather cycle
Know amounts of money in French
Know how to say which musical instrument you play or that you don't play an instrument
Know how to say where I live

Year 3

Know the formal and informal greetings for hello—salut and bonjour and for the time of the day
Know how to introduce yourself with simple phrases e.g. name (Je m'appelle) and age
Know how to say how you are feeling and respond when asked how they are—Ca va?
Know how to ask and answer simple questions e.g. someone else's name, feelings, age, things you have or not
Know colour words and how to describe shapes using a colour or size adjective
Know how to follow and give instructions
Know and say numbers 1-12
Know and name items in a school bag and recognise if they are masculine or feminine
Know how to speak/sing clearly and confidently when delivering a presentation or a song
Know how to research the definition of a noun in French and determine whether it is masculine or feminine
