### Computing

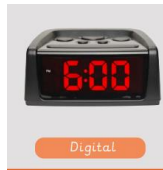
- A presentation program is used to present information to an audience in an engaging way, such as including text, pictures and videos. PowerPoint is an example of a presentation program.
