# Uniform

- White/red polo shirt or white shirt
- Red jumper/cardigan (these do not have to have the school logo on them)
- Charcoal/grey/black trousers/joggers (smart knee-length shorts may be worn in all year round if your child wishes)
- Charcoal/grey/black skirt or pinafore (red & white checked dress for warmer weather)
- Socks or tights should always be worn with shoes – no bare feet.
- Black flat school shoes/Black trainers are allowed to be worn during the school day as well as for PE lessons and clubs.

### **Parents will -**


- Support the school in its aims and values.
